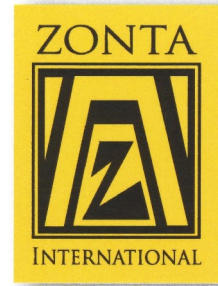


Zonta Club of Oakville will Paint the Town Yellow for International Women's Day!
